

## **Eighth Grade Class Trip 2008 – 2009**

### **Trip Details**

When: Monday, September 22 – Friday, September 26, 2008

Where: Camp Ocean Pines in Cambria, California

What: Ocean Ecology, Redwood Forest, Tidal Pools, Elephant Seal Sanctuary, Pelagic Sea Life, Sustainability, Building a Community

### **Transportation**

- Parents are responsible for getting students to the airport at 6:30 AM on Monday and picking up students at the airport at 10:00 PM on Friday
- One checked bag (with luggage tag) and one carry-on bag
- Traveling on Jet Blue Airlines, flying into Long Beach, California
- Private bus transportation from Long Beach, California to Cambria, California and back

### **Safety**

- Eight chaperones are currently scheduled to attend
- Cell phones will be allowed for students during travel. Cell phone service up at the camp is extremely limited.
- Parents will receive a school e-mail when the group arrives at Camp Ocean Pines
- Medication needs to be organized and given to school personnel before travel
- Medical Forms, the packing list, and flight numbers and times will given out at fall orientation to your students (the medical forms DO NOT require a doctor's signature).
