Due to conflicts with AP testing, the boys' soccer State 2A semi-final game featuring RHSM and American Leadership Academy which was scheduled to be played at Timpview High School on Friday, May 9 at 11:00 a.m. has been RESCHDULED for Friday, May 9 at 4:00 p.m. at American Leadership Academy. Directions to the Friday game follow:

American Leadership Academy: 1172 Delmonte Road
Spanish Fork, Utah
Travel south on I-15. Leave the freeway at the Spanish Fork exit. Go South on Main Street for approximately three miles until you come to a fork in the road and a traffic signal. Turn right onto the fork, which is Arrowhead Trail Road. Drive approximately one half mile on Arrowhead Trail Road and then take a right onto Del Monte Road. Go approximately one half mile on Del Monte Road and take a left onto 1100 South. The school is on your right. Field is on campus. Approximate travel time from SLC is 1 hour.

A win on Friday would send the RHSM team into the State 2A final vs. the winner of the St. Joe/South Summit game being played on Friday at Timpview High. The State Championship game is slated to be played at noon on Saturday, May

10 at Timpview High School. Directions to the possible Saturday game follow:

- Travel on I -15 South
- Take Orem/ Center Street Exit
- Go East to University Ave (approx. 3-4 miles)
- Turn Right on University Ave.
- Go 1 mile to 3700 N and Take Left
- Drive East for 6 Blocks-Timpview on Righthand side
- Field Located behind school
